What is happening?

MINOR FLOODING NO LONGER OCCURRING AT WILCANNIA

The Darling River at Wilcannia peaked at 9.93 metres on Tuesday 15 February with moderate flooding and is currently at 8.94 metres and falling, below the Minor Flood Level.

At Pooncarie, the Darling River is expected to remain below the Minor Flood Level (6.8 metres).

At Burtundy, the Darling River peaked near 6.12 metres on Thursday 17 February with minor flooding. River levels at Burtundy have fallen below the Minor Flood Level (6.1 metres).

What you need to do:

- STAY INFORMED Be prepared to act if your situation changes.
- Stay up to date with information. Listen to flood warnings and follow advice on how to protect yourself, family, and property.
- People working or camping along the Darling River should continue to monitor river heights.
- Motorists are reminded to use caution and drive to conditions. Flood debris such as mud, rocks or tree branches are likely to have been deposited across roads or low-level causeways which were affected by flood waters.
- Never drive, walk or play in floodwaters. Floodwater may be deep, fast flowing and may contain hidden snags and debris.
