- Encourage broad interest and support for the Baaka Culture and Art Centre from the Indigenous community;

Nominations are to include the name, contact details, representative's language group and a brief biography of the nominee supporting the claim to represent the language group.

The following appointment process will take place:

- All nominations received will be accepted by the Board
- Nominees will be invited to participate in the selection of 6 representatives for appointment to the Indigenous Reference Group.
- The final selections will be submitted to the Baaka Board for formal appointment to the Indigenous Reference Group.
