

Fish Deaths Review Team Returns

The team from the Office of the Chief Scientist and Engineer that's conducting an independent review of the fish deaths incidents in February and March is returning to Menindee and will be in town from Monday 26 June to Thursday 29 June.

A second round of Community listening sessions are being held at Menindee Civic Hall – 30 Yartla St Menindee – from 9.00am to 5.30pm.

The team has come back to hear from more Menindee residents so that vital information from local residents is included in the final report.

It wants to gather the thoughts, reflections, and if possible submissions so its report is as complete as possible.

These are not "town hall" presentation meetings. Rather, they are opportunities for the review team to listen to what the town of Menindee has to say.
