Roadworks Update: Smiths Hill and Turleys Hill projects

Central Darling Shire Council would like to advise that the Smiths Hill and Turleys Hill pavement reconstruction and sealing works, at White Cliffs, have been placed on hold because due to the realignment of the new roads some Telstra services within the construction footprint need to be relocated. Work is expected to resume once the services have been relocated.

The civil works for both ring roads are in progress.

The new ring roads will be sealed and include a small, sealed section at each driveway intersection to suit access.

Council is offering residents a light maintenance grade of the existing driveways as part of the construction works. Eligible residents need to contact Council if they would like this service: 08 8083 8800.

Council has received requests to seal full driveway access to dugout landings. However, this would result in additional construction costs, not budgeted for in the project scope. This option is therefore subject to resident contribution. Residents interested in sealing driveways should contact Council for further information.

The Turleys Hill works are funded through the Federal Governments Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program.

The Smiths Hill works are funded through the Transport NSW Fixing Local Roads Program.
